3. Write a short story with at least 3 emotions.

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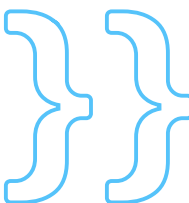
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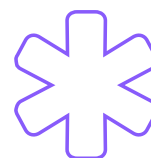
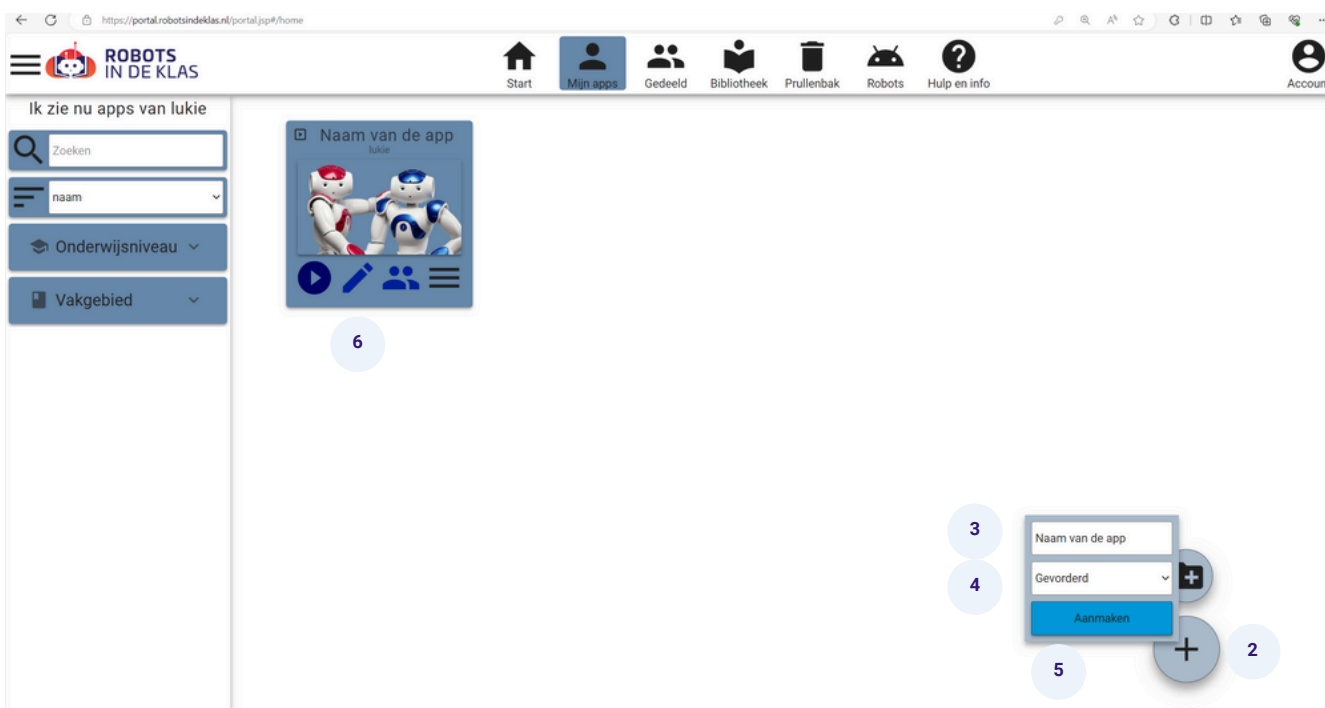
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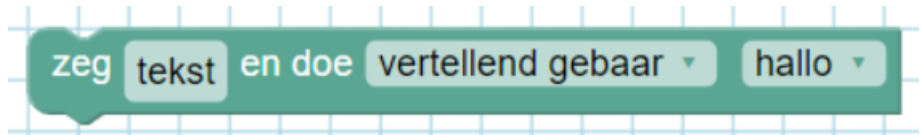
Take your laptop/tablet and go to playbotix.io.

1. Log in with your login credentials.
2. Create a new app by clicking on the big plus sign at the bottom right.
3. Name the app "Emotions 2".
4. Select "Advanced" instead of "Basic".
5. Click on "Create".
6. Click on the pencil icon next to the new app.



Today, you will work with the robot. Have the robot tell your story. Use the blocks from "Speech and Gestures." Make use of the green block below. Try to add emphasis to what you say by using appropriate movements.

You may also use the purple dance blocks from "Actions." These blocks are shown in the picture below. When you have completed this task, you can share it with the teacher



Was the robot able to tell and act out your story well? What would you do differently when telling the story?

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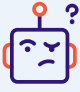






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Next Task
